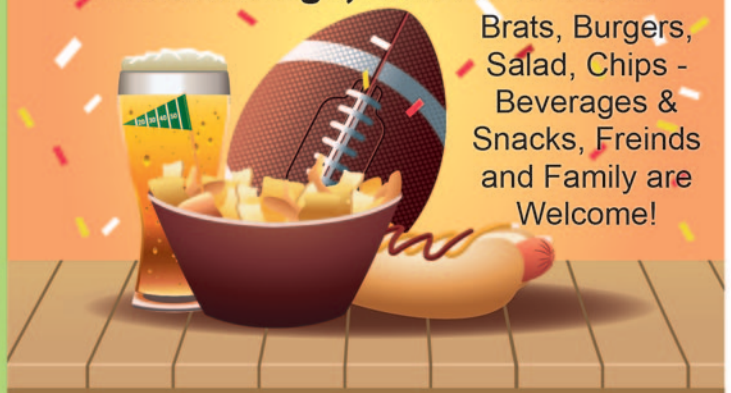

Currently, our dedicated staff is actively recruiting a hospitalist, and we are exploring the addition of an orthopedic hand specialist to bolster our craniofacial workload. These strategic moves align with our commitment to providing comprehensive and specialized care to our patients.

We are thrilled to announce that not only did they meet this target, but they also exceeded expectations through their dedicated fundraising efforts.
