News from Shriners Hospital Chicago

Shriners Hospitals for Children

SHC-Chicago is currently seeing an uptick in patients per week in the clinic with an additional 5-10 via Fast Track Video Visits. New patient referrals and new exams are approaching pre-COVID numbers. We are still utilizing three operating rooms per day and surgical minutes have increased. Waiting time to the next available appointment for most service lines is within three weeks.

The COVID rate in the Chicago area is at 2.9%, the lowest since September 2020. There is a light at the end of the tunnel.

The new pharmacy received its stamp of approval from the Illinois Department of Public Health and the pharmacy team moved into the new and improved space. The old pharmacy is being renovated and the space will be converted for use by other departments.

Watch for the new and improved Shriners Hospitals for Children website to be rolled out in early May. The new site will be more user-friendly and will be compatible across all platforms.
