A message from the Recorder/Trustee Building Manager regarding your Shrine Center

If you haven't been to the Shrine Center recently, many changes have occurred that are amazing. With the addition of the new Lodge Room and Masonic Museum/Library, we are truly a home for all Masons in Northeast Wisconsin. I did want to update you on a number of situations that we are dealing with.

Flooring: With the addition, we had new flooring placed in the large meeting room and hallways. This flooring is a high-quality flooring and was professionally installed in accordance with the recommendations of the manufacturer. However, we have encountered a problem not as a result of the flooring, but as a result of the ground we are built on. With the high ground water table, water runoff from our roof, and some identified drainage problems, we are having an increase of water coming up through our concrete floor. As a result, the glue used on the plank flooring is seeping through the seams of the flooring planks. We have also had to remove all tiles in the kitchen as the water coming through the concrete caused them all to come loose and become a safety issue. The trustees are diligently working on remedies for this problem, and we ask you to be patient as these are put in place. If you see a lime green substance on the floor, this is the glue. Just use a damp rag and wipe it up.

Silent Messenger: As a result of a wonderful donation, Beja will be installing a 9 ½ foot Silent Messenger Statue and a brick courtyard on the outside of the building on the southeast corner next to the date plaque on the building. Bricks for the courtyard can be purchased and engraved to recognize a Shriner and his family, a club or Unit, a masonic organization and any individual supporting Beja Shrine and our kids. Bricks cost \$100 for a 4x8 inch brick and \$200 for an 8x8 inch brick. To get a brick please contact the Beja office at 920-498-1985. For questions contact Gene Reece or Jeff Andersen.

Kitchen: We have done several upgrades to the kitchen to make us look more professional. We have purchased new white dinner and salad plates, stem water glasses and black dinner plates to provide options for dinners at the temple. We are also getting a large set of masonic dishes that will be available for Masonic dinner events. We are currently evaluating the purchase of a new refrigerator as our current one is older and becoming inefficient.

Main Room TV/Video system: The video system in the main dining room is up and running. All TVs are connected and can display not only live tv but presentations from *Continued in next column*

computers. This was used at our recent Sportsmen's Night and East/West Shrine Game with plenty of positive comments. The speaker system has also been upgraded with a much better sound quality.

ELECTION REGULATIONS

March 9, 2023

The following is the election regulations pertaining to all regular and special elections held by the Temple. Should you have any questions relating to these requirements, please contact the Temple Recorder – Eugene "Gene" Reece, Jr, P.P.

325.11 Election Regulations.

(a) Electioneering. A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a résumé consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.

(b) Expenditures Prohibited. The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.

(c) Violation. For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.

(d) Notice. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.

This notice meets the requirements of Section 325.11 pertaining to the notification of election regulations to all members by mail as outlined in para (d)


