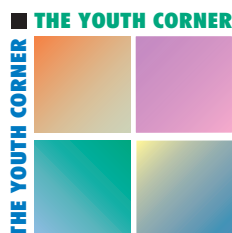
Remember, points toward the Samsar Award are earned for first- and second-line signers and top-line signers on affiliation and restoration petitions.

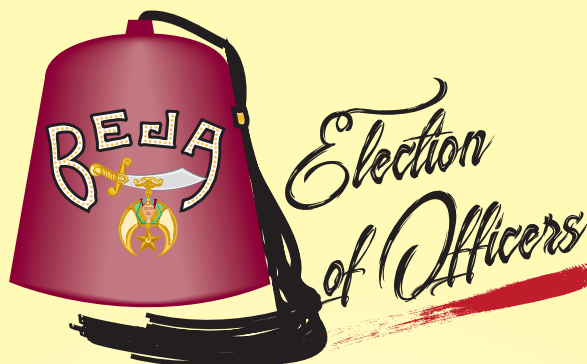

All persons entering Shriners Children's Chicago must be fully vaccinated and wear a face mask while in the facility. While masking is not required in some areas of the city, there continues to be a mandate for masking in healthcare facilities. Additionally, hospital van drivers/assistants must be fully vaccinated to transport patients. Any changes in this policy will be communicated in our weekly newsletter, the eBugler.

SC-Chicago is beginning to turn the corner as more staff become fully oriented and ready to work independently allowing less reliance on the traveling nurse staff.

Chicago's COVID risk level is currently listed as LOW. There has been a decrease in the number of cases reported by staff, patients, and guardians.

The Board of Governors, including associate members, will meet in person bi-monthly next year.
