
Sweet and Ready to Eat......

Remember, this is an agricultural product, so the availability of the onions is all dependent on Mother Nature. Onions sell for \$12 per bag for a 10# bag. They are delicious and if taken care of properly will last for months.

Pre-selling onions is easy to do, you can put up a flier at a local business, your church, or local watering hole, they sell themselves. By pre-selling you help us as well in making sure we cover your orders. Simply print this page or order form flyers are available at the Beja Office. Please contact Ann at 920-498-1985 to get yours today.

We ask that all pre-sold fliers/orders be turned in by April 8th so we can make sure we cover all our pre-sold orders. Onions not purchased through pre-sold orders will be sold on a first come first serve basis so pre-orders confirm your onion availability. If you have never sold any before and need help, let me know and I can help you out. Remember, when you buy a bag for yourself take 4 more to sell to your friends and neighbors. There are five 10# bags in every sleeve. You don't have to take a sleeve, but what a way to help. Remember, \$2 of every bag sold goes directly to the club or unit of your choice. 


