Effective April 17, 2023, masks are optional for providers, employees, volunteers, students, patients/families, and visitors in public spaces within our building.

The use of the Epic EMR can potentially increase revenue and reduce administrative workload and costs.

The first quarter of the year has been very exciting and busy with our patient volumes exceeding last year's levels as we continue to treat more patients and perform more complex surgeries.






