

Hello Everyone,





All persons entering Shriners Children's Chicago must be fully vaccinated and wear a face mask while in the facility. While masking is not required in some areas of the city, there continues to be a mandate for masking in healthcare facilities. Additionally, hospital van drivers/assistants must be fully vaccinated to transport patients. Any changes in this policy will be communicated in our weekly newsletter, the eBugler.

Craig McGhee, the new hospital administrator, attended his first Board of Governors meeting and brought the board up to date on the 2023 Strategic Operating Plan.

Dr. Pernendu Gupta, M.D., Chief of Staff, reported to the board that Dr. John Ghazi, M.D., has joined the Pediatric Orthopaedic group and will focus on spine and hip surgery.

Dr. Gupta and Dr. Michal Szcrodry, M.D. traveled to Shriners Children's Philadelphia where they received training on Anterior Vertebral Body Tethering (AVBT). AVBT is a new and minimally invasive technique available to skeletally immature scoliosis with the goal of controlling and correcting the curve. SC-Chicago is looking forward to offering this new procedure to our patients.

Traveling nurse staff continues to be used, which enables SC-Chicago to keep our usual patient volumes. As newly hired staff becomes oriented agency usage will be decreased.

Chicago's COVID risk level is currently listed as LOW. There are still a few instances of staff, patients, and guardians contracting COVID.

The Chicago Board of Governors continues to meet remotely, with in-person meetings held quarterly. 2023 will see the Board of Governors, including associate members, meet in person bi-monthly.
